Sealed bids will be received at the Middlesex County Board of Social Services, 181 How Lane, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08901 on or before **October 30, 2025**, for the FURNISHING OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS, REQUIRED BY THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY BOARD OF SOCIAL SERVICES. **All Bids must be received by 11:00 a.m. October 30, 2025.** Bids will be opened at 11:00 a.m. that day.

Specifications and bid forms for the proposed services are available at the office of the Board of Social Services, 181 How Lane, New Brunswick, New Jersey 08901 and may be inspected by prospective bidders during business hours. Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the specifications on proper notice.

Bids must be made on the standard bid form in the manner designated herein and as required by the bid specifications, and must be enclosed in sealed envelopes bearing the name of the job (FURNISHING OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS, REQUIRED BY THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY BOARD OF SOCIAL SERVICES), and the name and address of the bidder on the outside, addressed to the Middlesex County Board of Social Services, Attn. Kyle J. Trent, Board Counsel. When completing this package, please note in particular the requirements concerning the various insurance limits and items. Proof of compliance with the insurance requirements must be furnished when submitting your bid. Also, please note the requirement that you must include a signed service delivery plan as part of your bid package. Failure to do so will eliminate your bid from consideration. Bids may be hand-delivered or mailed by certified mail to the above-mentioned address.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of the Law Against Discrimination (P.L. 1975, c. 127).

A corporation submitting a bid in response to this advertisement shall accompany such a bid with a resolution authorizing its proper officers to submit such a bid, and authorize said officers to execute a Contract in the event its bid is accepted.
